About our District

The Applegate Valley Fire District proudly serves a population of approximately 5,100 people over a 181 square mile area. We are a combination department with 7 full-time staff members and dedicated volunteers responding out of 7 stations across our district. Our district was founded on May 12, 1980. We respond to medical calls, structure fires, wildland fire, motor vehicle accidents, rope and water rescue calls, and public assists in addition to working closely with local schools and organizations to further fire prevention and public education efforts.

POSITION SUMMARY

The individual responds to the emergency needs of the district and when not acting in that capacity, performs work that benefits the organization. The primary work activity involves fire suppression and emergency medical treatment. Secondary duties involve activities associated with the maintenance of district equipment, assisting with the delivery of training and public education programs. The rank of this position will vary per individual. The individual will usually begin as an Engineer and after a successful probationary period may be promoted by the Fire Chief. Generally, the individual will not be ranked higher than a Captain

Hours: 48 hours on-duty and 96 hours off
